Any water that runs down the storm drains flow directly into our waterways: Ganargua Creek, The Erie Canal or Red Creek. It does not pass through the sanitary sewer system, and it does not receive any kind of treatment.

People who would never dream of polluting a lake or a stream might pour antifreeze, fertilizer, paint or used motor oil, or toss pet waste, cigarette butts or litter down storm drains. Storm drain stenciling is a simple way to prevent this kind of pollution in your neighborhood.
